2005 Women in Motor Sport Scholarship

The inaugural A1 Grand Prix of Nations will bring together 25 teams to compete in 12 race events across the globe. With three days of on-track action at each race event, the A1 Grand Prix brings the thrill of international motor sport to billions of fans.

The NSW Premier's Department, Office for Women, in association with Emirates Airlines and the A1 Team Australia are offering the chance for one young woman (aged 18 to 25 years as at November 1st, 2005) to be part of the A1 Team Australia's pit crew in two of the upcoming A1 Grand Prix of Nations race events.

The winner will attend the Sydney leg of the race at Eastern Creek on November 4th, 5th & 6th 2005, and then fly Emirates Airlines to Dubai with the Australian team on December 7th, returning on December 12th, 2005. The total prize, including a return flight to Dubai and accommodation, is valued to AUS \$5,500.

You will need to be available for media and race events from late October to mid-December 2005.

1. Information on how to enter forms part of these terms & conditions. Any entry not complying with these terms and conditions is invalid.
2. Entry is open to female residents of New South Wales aged between 18 and 25 years. Employees of the Promoter, the Promoter's associated companies, the Promoter's agencies associated with this promotion and their immediate families are ineligible to enter. Proof of age documentation will be required from entrants reaching the final interview stage.
3. The Promotion closes last mail received on **7/10/2005**.
4. To enter, applicants must write a 400 words or less descriptive answer to the question: "I am passionate about being involved in motor racing because..." This must be accompanied by some background information on the entrant and sent by post to: Women in Motor Racing Scholarship, NSW Premier's Department, Office for Women, GPO Box 5341, SYDNEY NSW 2001. The form can also be faxed to 9228 3571.
5. The winner must have a valid passport to June 2006, and be available for media and race events from October to December 2005 where practical and with due notice.
6. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and reserves the right to disqualify any entrant for tampering with the entry process, or for submitting an entry that is not in accordance with these Conditions of Entry.
7. A number of entrants will be selected for interviews to be held at the offices of A1 Grand Prix of Nations office in Sydney in **October 2005**. The winner will be notified by telephone and/or mail.
8. The prize comprises a return flight to Dubai on Emirates Airlines, accommodation in Dubai for the term of the race event, all travel and health insurance, and a daily meal allowance. If required, travel and accommodation within NSW will be taken into account.
9. The winner will be required to submit a 2-page Reflective Learning Report to the Office for Women by the close of the scholarship period.
10. Total prize pool is valued at up to \$5,500 AUD
11. Prize is not transferable & cannot be taken as cash.

The NSW Premier's Department is not liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered, including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss, or for personal injury suffered or sustained during the course of accepting or using the prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.
13. All entries become the property of the Promoter.
