Perpetrators of domestic and family violence can often be invisible across the service system and have no choice but to return home or face homelessness.

Fixed Address

As part of the Domestic and Family Violence Innovation Fund Kempsey Families Inc. is developing the *Fixed Address* project to provide a coordinated approach to the delivery of accommodation and case management for perpetrators of violence to keep victims and families safe.

This three year project will take a complete approach to victim safety by considering the material needs of the perpetrator and will disrupt cycles of reoffending and revictimisation.

What is the project?

The needs of perpetrators will be supported through assessment, referral and case coordination services for domestic and family violence related court matters and accommodation. The project will be delivered in the Port Macquarie-Hastings, Kempsey Macleay, Coffs Harbour and Nambucca Heads areas.

Fixed Address will support the NSW Domestic and Family Violence Blueprint for Reform 2016-2021 by preventing reoffending of domestic and family violence and supporting victims in communities across NSW.
